With the Hampshire County Council Elections taking place on Thursday 4 May, your local Conservative Team has a positive message.

■ The Conservatives in Hampshire have a track record of success. Over the last four years, six extra care homes have been created. £100m has been invested in roads whilst broadband coverage has been boosted to 95% of the population. The Hampshire Cultural Trust has been established to secure 26 local museums and attractions. This has all been delivered whilst council tax rates are one of the lowest in the UK.

Conservative candidate for Petersfield Butser Robert Mocatta has pledged to push

SUPPORTING LOCAL SCHOOLS

■ After frozen council tax for many years, Hampshire County Council has a real-term reduction after inflation of £100 compared to 2010. This year sees a 3% increase to directly fund social care.

The County Council plans to spend £762m on education services in 2016/7, 40% of its overall expenditure. At secondary age over 98% of children get into one of their top three choices. Examination results are above the national average, and 90% of primary schools are rated good or outstanding. Supporting local schools in continuing to raise standards is a key goal for local Conservative councillors.
