### BENTWORTH, SELBORNE AND WIELD

Alton Rural has numerous BOATS - many made impassable by 4x4s. I pledge to bring in 4x4 bans on BOATS in Bentworth, Selborne and Wield and beyond so that these beautiful lanes can be enjoyed by walkers, cyclists and horseriders.
